

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

#### MORISSET HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

The Morisset High School Scholarship encourages Year 12 students at Morisset High School to complete their tertiary education at Avondale University.

#### **DETAILS**

The Morisset High School Scholarship is worth \$2000 per student. The successful applicants receive \$1000 each semester in the first year of a certificate, diploma or undergraduate degree course. The money for the scholarship comes from the Morisset ADRA Op Shop, which donates its proceeds for the benefit of the local community.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

The Morisset High School Scholarship is available to three students who complete Year 12 at Morisset High School and enrol in a certificate, diploma or undergraduate degree course at Avondale.

#### CONDITIONS

The Morisset High School Scholarship is awarded subject to the recipients by census date:

- Meeting normal requirements for direct admission as full-time students into a certificate, diploma or undergraduate degree course at Avondale;
- Completing the Morisset High School Scholarship Application Form, and;
- Completing an interview with the Morisset High School Scholarship panel.

#### **MANAGEMENT**

Applicants submit the Morisset High School Scholarship Application Form to the Administration Office of Morisset High School by the published deadline. A panel consisting of a Morisset High School representative, an Avondale representative, and a Morisset ADRA Op Shop Local Management Committee member will choose recipients. Student Finance Services will apply the semester value of the Morisset High School Scholarship to the recipients' tuition account after census date.



## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

#### **CRITERIA**

Applicants for the Morisset High School Scholarship must:

Describe their need for the scholarship and their contribution to school, community or family.

Recipients of the Morisset High School Scholarship must:

- Maintain a full-time study load per semester (however recipients may apply in writing to the Director of Student Administration Services for consideration in extenuating circumstances);
- Maintain an academic status of good standing (which, for full-time students, means passing at least three units per semester), and;
- Maintain good standing in the community. (Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.)

Recipients of the Morisset High School Scholarship cannot:

- · Redeem the scholarship for cash, and;
- Transfer or defer the scholarship.

#### **APPLICATION DETAILS**

Applicants should complete the Morisset High School Application Form and submit it to the Morisset High School Administration Office by the end of week five in term three of the school year.
