Purpose of the Prize

The prize recognises excellence in nursing practice for a consistent high level of clinical performance over the three years of the Bachelor of Nursing course.

Selection Criteria

Bachelor of Nursing graduands for the year are reviewed on the following criteria.

- On the *Clinical and Professional Practice Appraisal* form used to review student performance across the course, a high standard is recorded on a majority of appraisals throughout the course and there are no areas of unsatisfactory performance during the course.
- On the *Assessment of Standards of Practice* form used to review student performance, the student performs at a high standard throughout the course and is at the upper end of the scale for their level of experience during the course.

Administration of the Prize

The School of Nursing and Health will meet in August/September to review students who meet the selection criteria.

Sponsorship

The prize shall be provided by way of a pre-paid gift card to the value of \$500. presented by the Nursing Executive Officer at Sydney Adventist Hospital or delegate. Sponsorship is provided by the Adventist HealthCare.

Presentation of Prize
