

BRISBANE WATERS PRIVATE HOSPITAL CLINICAL PRACTICE EXCELLENCE PRIZE

Purpose of the Prize

The prize recognises an excellent consistent performance in nursing practice by a student during clinical placements across the spectrum of nursing fields in the Bachelor of Nursing course.

Selection Criteria

Avondale University Bachelor of Nursing students are reviewed on the following criteria:

1. On the *Clinical and Professional Practice Appraisal* form used to review student performance across the course, a high standard is recorded on a majority of appraisals throughout the course and there are no areas of unsatisfactory performance during the course.
2. On the *Assessment of Standards of Practice* form used to review student performance, the student performs at a high standard throughout the course and is at the upper end of the scale for their level of experience during the course.

Administration of Prize

The Avondale University School of Nursing will coordinate the administration of the prize in consultation with academic staff. Following the clinical placements in the first 5 semesters of the course, candidates are reviewed and a suitable student selected by the School of Nursing Committee. The School of Nursing staff will meet in August/September to review students who meet the selection criteria.

Sponsorship

The prize shall be provided by way of a pre-paid gift card to the value of \$500. The prize is awarded annually with sponsorship provided by Brisbane Waters Private Hospital.

Presentation of Prize

A certificate and voucher are awarded to the selected student. The prize will be presented by a representative of Brisbane Waters Private Hospital (if feasible) at the Friday night graduation lamp-lighting ceremony, or other opportunity deemed agreeable.
