


Journal Search

Journal Search gives you another way to search for journal articles.




The screenshot shows the Avondale University Library website navigation menu with 'JOURNAL SEARCH' circled in blue. Below the menu is a search interface with the following elements:

Journal Title

Type in the name of the Journal (not the title of the article). This will take you to the journal itself, where you select year, volume and issue to locate the article. Or, if you know the journal is recommended for your field of study, browse the journal through their search function for other articles.
