

How do I find an item if I only have limited information about it?

Let's say you only remember one word from the title and maybe only the author's surname. Try using *Advanced Search* to enter the details you do remember.



Hint: Start with just the author's surname. Names are sometimes listed as John Sullivan, J. Sullivan, J. W. Sullivan etc. Putting in the surname only will bring up all the listings.

You can also refine your search by *Date*, *Location*, and *Resource Type* using the filters on the left-hand side of the screen.
