TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

Assessments include written questions, quizzes, case studies, and observations of practical skills in workplace environments. Participants will be supported by their trainer throughout their learning journey.

COURSE DURATION AND DELIVERY

Delivered over 2-3 days each week on campus with required time for self-directed study. 120 hours of work placement is required as part of this qualification.

WORK PLACEMENT

Work placement is a mandatory part of the course. It provides industry-based experience and practical assessment. 120 hours of work placement is required as part of this qualification.

Students will need to meet any work place requirements when completing work placement. These could include, evidence of immunisations, national police and NDIS checks. Avondale is able to assist with work placement arrangements.
