- HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Enrolment and Completion Steps:

- Step 1 Complete the application and pay for the course via credit card / debit card
- Step 2 Receive an email with course details and instructions to log in
- Step 3 Complete your theory and knowledge questions online
- **Step 4** Participate in the face-to-face practical training and assessment session

Course Content:

- Recognising and assessing emergency situations, ensuring the safety of those around you
- Providing first aid and/or perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in accordance with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines
- Operating first aid equipment following manufacturers' instructions
- Accurately conveying incident details to emergency services
- Contributing to a review of the first aid response, including psychological impacts on yourself and others

Assessment:

To successfully complete the course, you must demonstrate competency in three assessments:

- 1. Online reading and multiple-choice questions for ALL topics
- 2. Observation assessment during the face-to-face practical
- 3. Incident report submitted during the practical session

Completing the online knowledge questions (assessment #1) is mandatory before attending the practical session. Failure to do so may result in being unable to participate in the practical training.
